Purpose			Modernising and developing public electricity supply.
Relevance to the biomethane sector			This act establishes the legal framework for the purchase of and payment for electricity from renewable sources (art. 10 Loi n°2000-108), the conditions regarding tenders (art. 8 Loi n°2000-108) and provisions on the funding of the support system (art. 5 Loi n°2000-108).
Relation to EU legislation			This law follows up the European Directive 96/92/CE of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19/12/96 regarding the common rules on the electricity market. All the major principals of the European directives are taken in, in which the role of the incumbent operator is defined, as well as the roles of the network operators, the electricity regulatory commission and of course public service missions.
Scope			This law is based on the procurement strategy of electricity in France; the independence and securisation of the procurement; the fight against the greenhouse effect and the preservation of the air quality; the development of national resources; the control of energy demand; the competitiveness of the economy, the directions of technologies and respect for the environment.
