Name of legislative act			Gouvernement Decree 382/2007. (XII. 23.) on authority licensing procedures for construction of electricity facilities
Date of Publication			23 December, 2007
Date of implementation			1 January, 2008.
Purpose			The aim of the Government Decree is to regulate the authority licensing procedures in connection with the electric power industry.
Relevance to the biomethane sector			Based on the Act of Electric Energy, this Government Decree regulates the types of the licences which are obligatory to the power plant's operation. Furthermore it declares the provisions of the power plant construction.
