Scope			<p>Art 1: Energy policy is based on a public service that guarantees energy strategic independence of the nation and promotes economic competitiveness. Its conduct requires the maintenance and development of national and local public enterprises in the energy sector.</p> <p>This policy aims to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Contribute to national energy independence and guarantee security of supply; - Ensure competitive energy prices; - Safeguard human health and the environment, particularly by fighting against the worsening of the greenhouse effect; - Ensure social and territorial cohesion by ensuring universal access to energy. <p>The State shall ensure the consistency of its action with that of local authorities and the European Union along the lines set out in the accompanying Reports.</p>
